

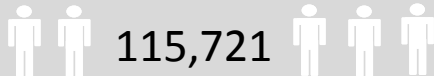

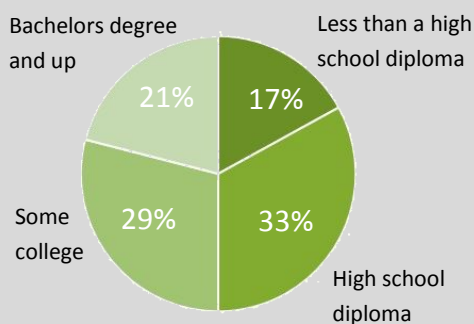
Quick Look: Bibb County

In September 2018, Bibb County DREAM Team will be promoting city-wide events and recruitment activities in honor of Literacy Month

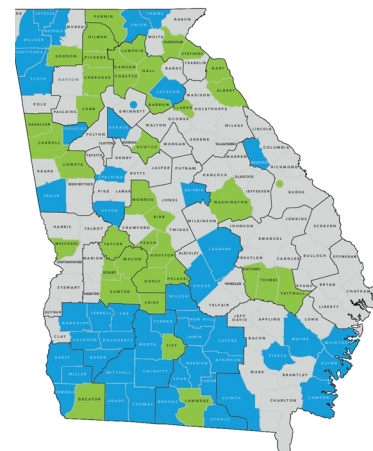
