### **CRITERIA FOR CERTIFICATION AS A CERTIFIED LITERATE COMMUNITY**

#### **CRITERION ONE**

The commitment of leading public and private community organizations was secured and documented during Participant status.

#### **CRITERION TWO**

Public awareness and demand for a Literate Community was created and sustained during Participant status.

#### **CRITERION THREE**

Enrollment was achieved and services provided to the extent necessary to achieve the designation Certified Literate Community during Participant status.

#### **CRITERION FOUR**

Progress has been assessed and documented and the community has worked to publicly recognize the economic, social and cultural benefits of literacy skill improvements achieved by the community during Participant status.

#### **CRITERION FIVE**

The community successfully sustained, for the time required, a program which has led to the official designation, Certified Literate Community.

#### **CRITERION SIX**

Plans are in place for the future to sustain awareness, understanding and demand in such a way that will work toward the eradication of illiteracy.
