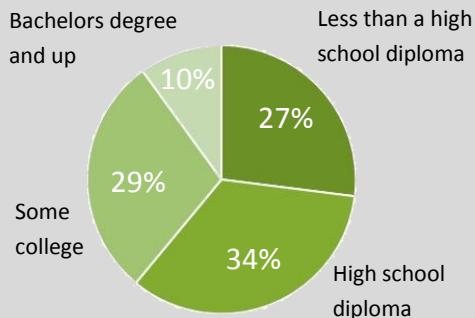

Population: Adults 18+



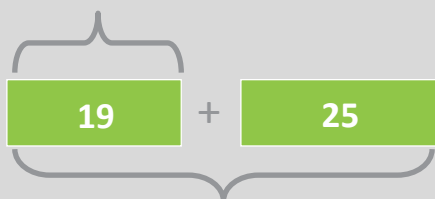
Educational Attainment: Adults 18+

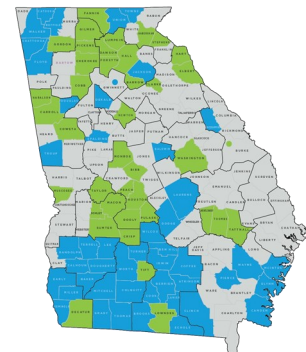
